The goal is to explore the historical entanglements and present-day relations between Cameroon and Germany from an artistic perspective – through dance, theatre, voice, body and memory.

The project is a collaboration between Theater im Depot (Dortmund, Germany) and Patrie Art (Douala, Cameroon), a cultural collective dedicated to preserving living heritage, decolonization and reclaiming cultural knowledge in Cameroon.

Who are we looking for?

Artists based in NRW and surrounding regions who are curious about interdisciplinary, international collaboration. You work with body, voice, movement or language? You want to artistically engage with memory, colonial history, future and community? Then this is for you.

What is it about?

Together with artists from Cameroon and NRW, we will create a performative work addressing the colonial legacy of the 1884 'protection treaty' between Germany and Cameroon – and its echoes today.

Thematic Focus:

- → Memory & History
- → Intergenerational Perspectives & Collective Knowledge
- → Social Transformation & Cultural Self-Determination

The lab will take place in Dortmund and will culminate in a public showing and an accompanying discourse and workshop proramme.
